

THE ROBERT JONES SCHOLARSHIP FOR REFUGEE DAUGHTERS

Information for Study in 2020

Applications are now open for students who are currently enrolled in a degree-level qualification from a university or an approved tertiary institution and who wish to continue their tertiary study in 2020. Applicants must have completed and passed their university level course work to date. You must submit your semester one results as soon as they are available.

Students in their last year of school in 2019 should enrol at their preferred institute of study for 2020 under the fees free scheme and apply for the scholarship after their first semester of study.

Applications close on August 12, 2019. Interviews will be held in Auckland and Wellington in October 2019.

The RJH Scholarship will cover academic fees for subsequent years providing the student continues to pass their course.

Hostel fees will be paid for two years for students who are required to study outside their home town.

Your application must include

- Completed and **typed** application form
- Proof of status that you or your family are from a refugee background
- An official transcript of your **most recent** academic records
- A cover letter which informs us about your family background and personal story; why you are applying for this scholarship, your experience of tertiary level study and what you hope to do in the future
- Two written references - one academic reference and one character reference
